Naming streets and a park in the northern part of the precinct (June 2020)



From Wednesday 3 to Wednesday 24 June 2020, the City of Parramatta Council sought feedback from the community to help in naming three streets and a park in the northernmost part of the Carter Street Precinct in Lidcombe.



Nine names were put forward as options for the three streets that require naming. Respondents were asked to choose their top three options.

The most popular names selected via the survey were:



59% Kingfisher Street



53% Blue Wren Street



50% Honeyeater Street

The least popular names selected via the survey were:



Three names were put forward as options for the unnamed park. Respondents were asked to choose their top option.

Ranking of proposed park names via the survey:



Community feedback will be considered along with feedback from other stakeholders when determining which names are recommended to Council for endorsement.

JUL 2020 - AUG 2020 Anticipated period for Council to consider naming proposals for the northernmost part of the precinct. Pending endorsement from Council, recommended name proposals are then submitted to the NSW Geographical Names Board.



AUG 2020 - SEP 2020 Anticipated final



approval from the NSW Geographical Names Board. Once approved, names for the northernmost part of the precinct are published in the Government Gazette and take effect. Place names are then installed in the precinct.
