- install a permanent fence install a permanent water station near nursery that doubles as dog water bowl in off-leash area (near Council Nursery)
- replace Betty's Bridge install of one new disabled car parking space and kerb ramp on Cowells Lane

The temporary fence will remain in the interim until the permanent dog fence is constructed on site. The new fence will be designed to ensure universol access for all park users.
