of respondents believe that the Dundas Village Shops requires an **UPGRADE**

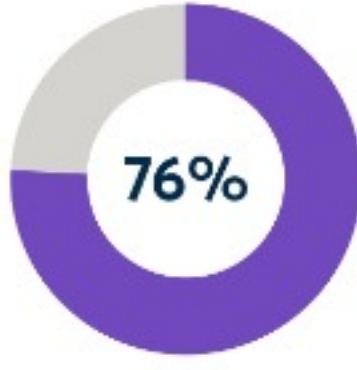


38% **VISIT THE SHOPS** a few times a week
