- ⑤ Proposed new seats with back rest for playground area.
- ⑥ Existing picnic shelter to be retained and re-orientated in place, new picnic table setting to be provided.
- ⑦ Existing large picnic shelter to be retained and relocated to new location, new picnic table setting to be provided.
- ⑧ Existing path to be retained and protected.
- ⑨ Existing trees to be retained and protected.
- ⑩ Existing park sign to be retained and protected.
- ⑪ Retain existing bin for playground.

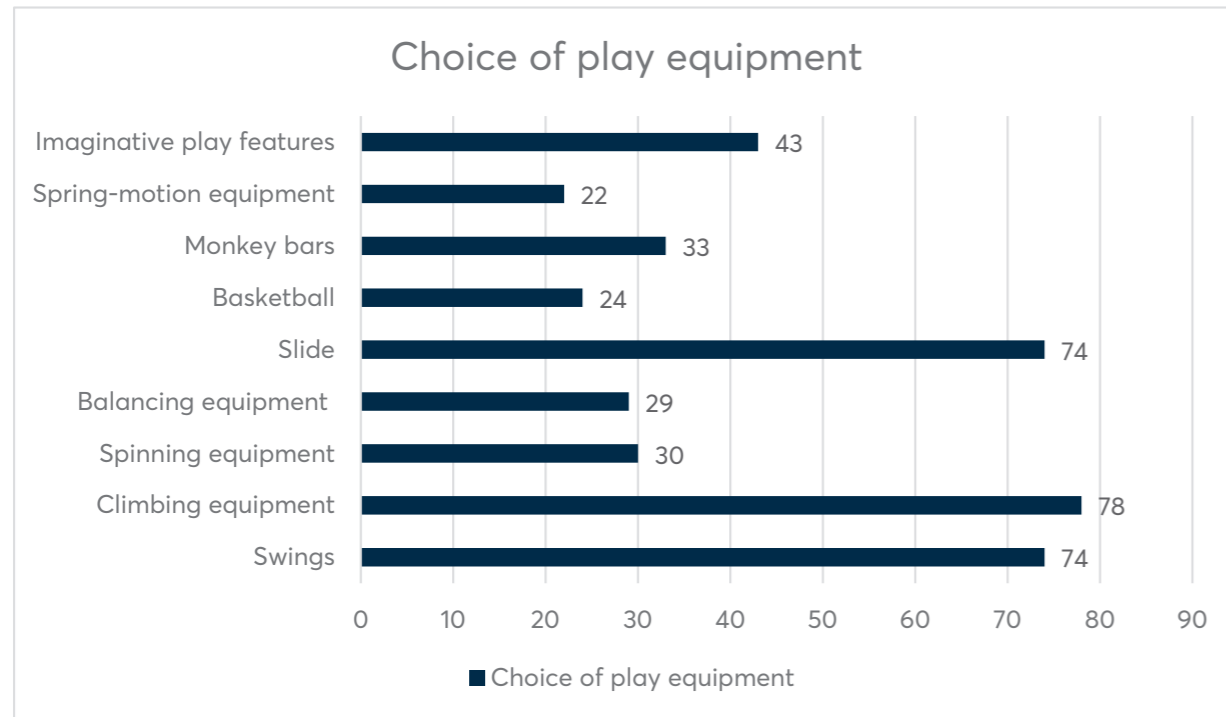
